



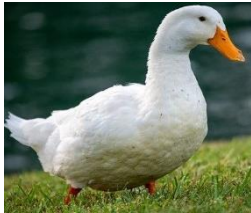

DUCKS



PEKIN

The Pekin is the most common duck in North America. They grow very quickly (7 lbs. in 6 weeks) and up to 12 lbs full grown. They also lay a generous amount of large eggs making them unbeatable as a dual purpose duck.



ROUEN

The Rouen was developed in France and looks almost identical to the Mallard but is about 2-3 times larger. They are a lean bird and are said to have very flavourful meat. They are moderate layers with some blue/green coloured eggs



BLACK SWEDISH

The Black Swedish is a medium weight duck about the same size as the Rouen (5-7 lbs.) The ducklings hatch black with the distinct white patch on their breast. They are calm and very hardy.



BUFF ORPINGTON

The Buff Orpington is a medium weight duck (5-7 lbs) and excellent layers. Their under- feathers are very light giving the carcass a clean appearance. An excellent dual purpose bird.



WELSH HARLEQUIN

The Welsh Harlequin is an excellent dual purpose duck although not quite as large (4.5-6 lbs). They are handsome birds and good layers. They are very calm making them a great addition to your pond or back yard.



INDIAN RUNNERS

Indian Runners are a unique addition to your flock. They are a lightweight duck with a vertical stance. They are good layers with some of the eggs a blue/green colour.



KHAKI CAMPBELL

The Khaki Campbell is widely known as the best laying heritage breed duck. They are excellent layers and good foragers making them very economical birds.



CAYUGA

These beautiful medium sized birds are naturally quite calm and make great pets or backyard buddies. They lay a decent amount of grey (sometimes black)eggs.



WHITE CRESTED

This is our second year with the Crested ducks and we do not have many breeders yet so supply is still quite limited. A small percentage hatch with no crest but we ship only ducklings with a visible crest.



WHITE MUSCOVY

The Muscovy is an excellent forager and are great mothers. None of the other breeds will sit on eggs as readily as the Muscovy. They are able to fly but will always nest on the ground. The male is about twice the size of the female.



PEARL GUINEA FOWL

Guineas are prized for their bug control and are said to be especially fond of ticks. They are also used as barnyard guards, sounding a loud

staccato warning when they feel threatened. These are French Guinea fowl and are bred to be good meat birds weighing about 3-4 lbs. in 12-14 weeks. If they are free ranging there is very little additional feed needed.

GEESE



EMBDEN

The Embden is the most common goose grown for meat due to its large size, white feathers and rapid growth. They are very hardy and can live up to 20 years or more.



TOULOUSE

The Toulouse was developed in France and the most popular barnyard/backyard goose. They are handsome birds and appear large but are not as aggressive as some breeds. They can also be grown for meat, weighing about the same as the Embden.



BROWN CHINESE

The Brown Chinese is a light weight goose but makes up for its size with its loud call and sometimes aggressive behaviour. They are excellent foragers and sometimes called "weeder" geese



SADDLEBACK POMERANIAN

The Saddleback Pomeranian is a large, majestic goose with a coloured heart on its back. We have 2 colours, Buff and Grey. Stock is still limited this year.
